According to the conference title, the main topics are water and fish. Welcomed are all those interested in or studying aquatic environment and aquatic organisms, aquaculture, fishery...

As usual, the best scientists from the sector, representatives from different countries, associations, institutions, and projects will participate as lecturers. Deadline for paper submission: Papers in English, with extended (2 pages), abstract in Serbian should be sent till 1st May 2015 (see Guidelines for paper preparation). Abstract translation into Serbian will be provided for

conference participants whose mother tongue is not Serbian, Croatian or Bosnian. Papers should be submitted by e-mail to: ribarstvo@agrif.bg.ac.rs

Apart from invited speakers from Serbia and the world, contributions from scientists and professionals interested are welcomed.

Official languages: English (Simultaneous interpretation of the oral presentations will be provided).

Papers will be peer reviewed and, published in the book of proceedings which will be included in conference packs.

Paper presentation: Oral or poster presentation, according to the wish of the author. Final decision will be given by the Scientific Committee.

Registration fee: 50 € for all participants. Guidelines for paper submission

Manuscripts, in English, with extended (2 pages) abstract in Serbian should be prepared on A4 paper size, one sided, margins: top, bottom, left, and right 2.5 cm, without header and footer, double spacing, font Times New Roman 12 points. Paper length: even number of pages (maximum 8 pages, including tables and figures). Extended abstracts should be written in English and in Serbian, following guidelines for complete papers and with the maximum number of pages not exceeding 4. Abstract translation into Serbian will be provided for conference participants whose mother tongue is not Serbian, Croatian or Bosnian.

Research papers should contain following chapters: Title, extended Abstract (for international participants, abstract translation from English to Serbian will be provided by the Editor), Key words, Introduction, Material and methods, Results, Discussion (optional Results and Discussion), Conclusions, Acknowledgements, and References.

ARTICLE TITLE (CAPITAL LETTERS 12 POINTS, BOLD, CENTRED)

(One blank row)

Authors (names in capital letters, full addresses, name of the institution italic, centred)

(Two blank rows)

Extended Abstract two pages including title: 12 points, italic; justified,

Text: 12 points, normal, justified

(one blank row)

Key words 12 points, italic, text: 12 points, up to 5 words.

(two blank rows)

Chapter titles (INTRODUCTION, MATERIALS AND METHODS, RESULTS, DISCUSSION, CONCLUSIONS, ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS, REFERENCES) capital letters, 12pt
(one blank row after chapter title)

The whole text of the paper (including literature) should be 12 points, justified. The Latin names of species used in the investigation should be italicized.

References should be given alphabetically in the following way:

For books, name of the author(s), date of publication, title, edition, publisher's name, and place of publication, page reference, should be given, e.g.:

Pillay, T.V.R., Kutty, M.N (2005): *Aquaculture - Principles and Practices*. Blackwell Publishers. Oxford. 624 pp.
